INTERPRETATION OF SCORES

Each score is reported on a standard scale that permits direct comparison of scores achieved by candidates tested at different times. The LSAT scale ranges from 200 to 800. The scale for the measure of writing ability ranges from 20 to 80.

The actual numerical values of a candidate's scores have meaning only when compared with scores made by other candidates. Such comparison can be made by referring to the tables at the right, which show the percentage of the candidates taking the test in the designated period whose scores fell below each score given.

Law schools set their own standards for selecting their entering classes, and each school places somewhat different emphasis on test scores used in conjunction with college records, honors or awards, recommendations, and other information. It is strongly urged that candidates not use these tables as a means of deciding whether to have a score report sent to a particular law school.

The admissions data provided by the law schools in the *Prelaw Handbook* should be consulted. Most law schools supply information in the *Handbook* on the standards they applied in selecting the class for the current year.
